*For anybody who is interested, we had 99 cars on the field at the Glenwood car show, up from 48 last year (due to competing events) and down from a high of 107 in 2004. 6 of them were Triumphs. At this rate, there will only be one car show class for all Triumphs next year, down from the present 3, since 3 of the 6 will be in Premier class next year. RMTC member Roger Baillargeon took first place in TR2-3-4-250-6 class with his 1964 TR4. Other Triumph awards went to Jeff Otto with a 1978 Spitfire. A well deserved Diamond in the Rough went to a 1970 Spitfire belonging to Brian Fulghum. He won by such a landslide we eventually quit bothering to count the votes in that class. - Dave F.*

I was there and can say that it was a great 60th Anniversary celebration. A good time was had by all and if you weren't able to attend this year think about joining the fun next year!

## ***The "Sports Car Market" by Gordon Kenney***

This is a monthly publication that has articles about collecting, investing and marketing of interesting cars and lists the results of car auctions around the world. The following material is from the July 2012 issue.

A two page article about a full body-off professional restoration of a 1960 Triumph TR3A that sold for \$45,100 at Auctions America in Ft Lauderdale, FL on 3/17/2012.

A 55 Triumph TR2 with a new restoration and several upgrades sold for \$32,400 at Branson, MO auction in April 2012. Also, a 67 Triumph Spitfire Mk II, condition 2 (out of 5), sold for \$10,530.

At the Mecum Auction in Kansas City in March 2012, a very nice 76 TR6, claimed to have only 410 miles, not sold at a bid of \$32,000. And from the current Autoweek a report of a 65 TR4A selling for \$30,800 at RM Auctions in Amelia Island, Fl. On March 10, 2012.

These selling prices seem substantially higher than cars sell for in our region. These auctions are "away" but it may be worth the effort if you have a good one to sell.

Gordon - Moonlight dinner on August 4 th.


Silvio -The Rendevoez Car Show in Winter Park will be July 14th
